

At the heart of ThinkCERCA is a research-based framework for teaching students how to read, write, and think critically across subjects.

For students to be prepared for the world ahead, they need to be willing, ready, and able to make **Claims**, support their claims with **Evidence**, explain their **Reasoning** clearly, address **Counterarguments**, and use language appropriate for their **Audience**. We call this a CERCA.

The clarity and organization of CERCA helps teachers make the instructional shift of bringing literacy instruction into their everyday practice. When students, teachers, and administrators use the same words and framework to discuss literacy, everyone can collaborate on the process with ease.

In fact, studies show that as students strengthen their CERCA skills, they can achieve an average of two years of growth in a single school year.
